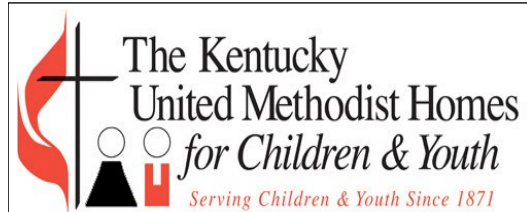

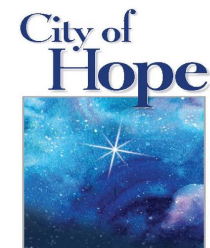
IDA SPENCE CHRISTMAS PROJECT - BEGAN NOVEMBER 16

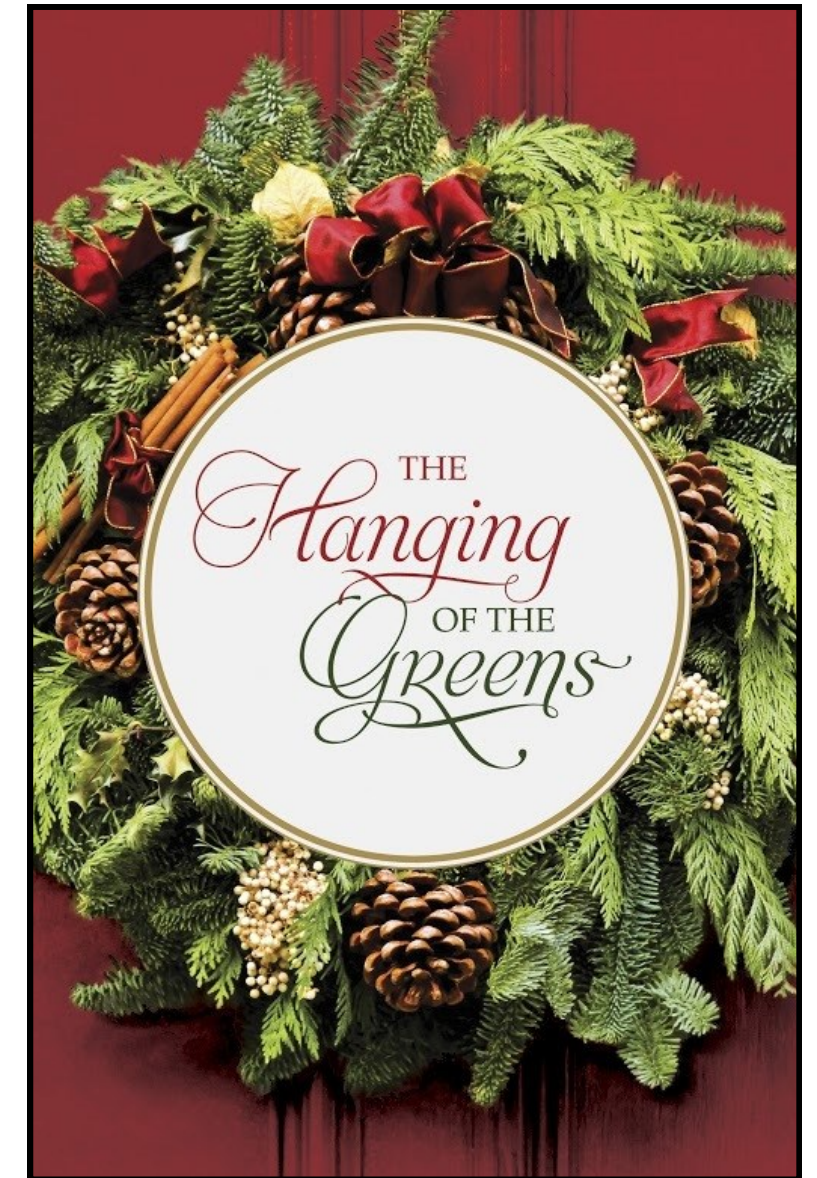
