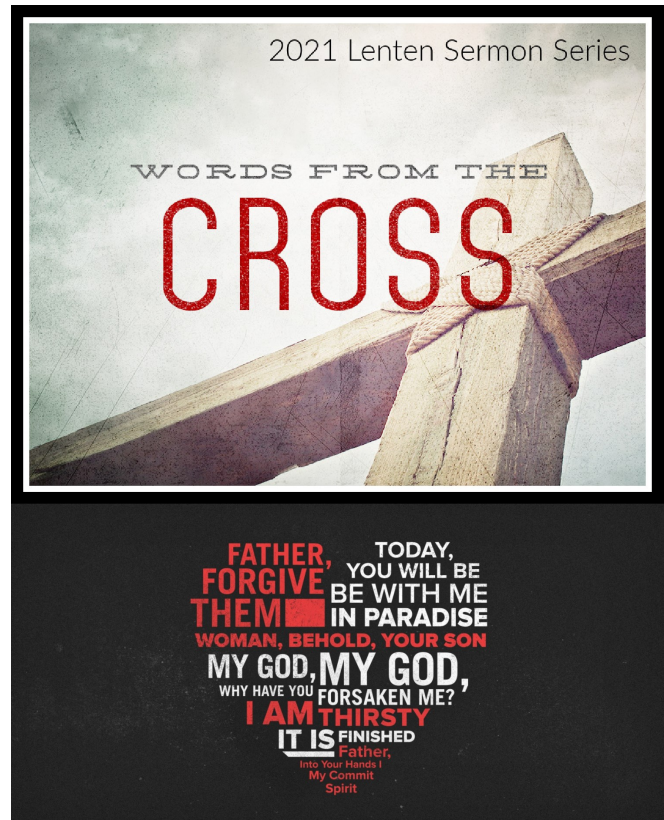

SERMON

“Father Forgive Them”
Luke 23:33-38
