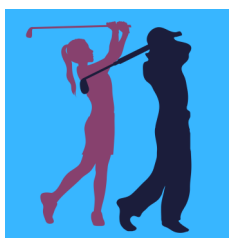
FLOOD BUCKETS

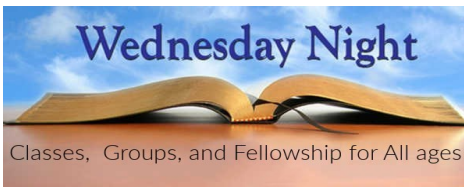
