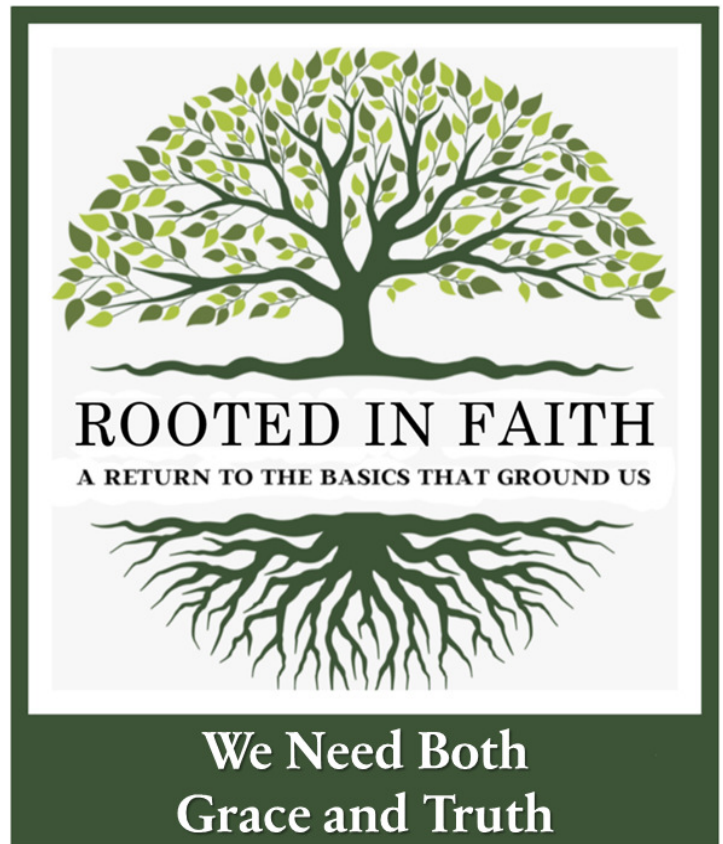

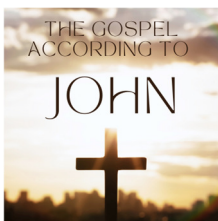

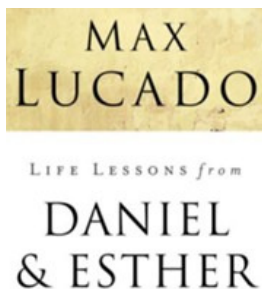


THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO JOHN

Come and hear the Gospel according to John with us! This class will be held in-person in the Sanctuary, but it will also be live-streamed for online participation.

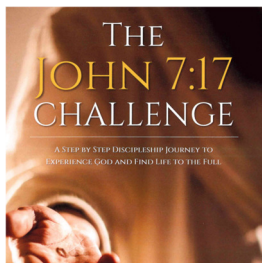


WOMEN'S BIBLE STUDY

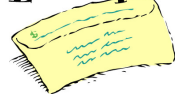
