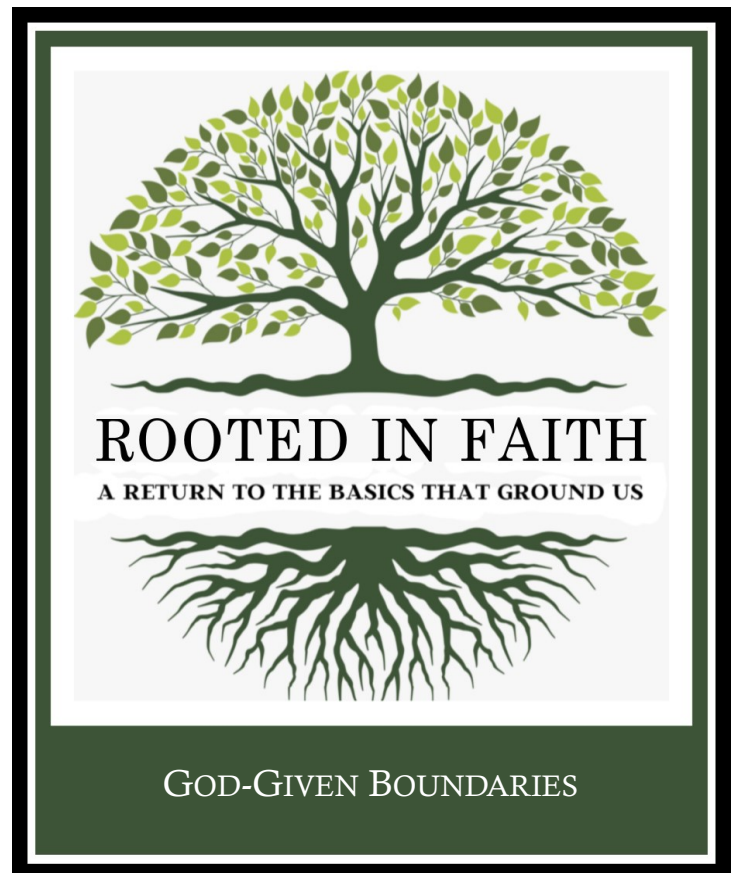

IMPORTANT REMINDERS FOR OUR CHURCH CONFERENCE VOTE

- We will meet on Sun, February 19, 2023 at 4:00 p.m. at Lakeside Park Campus.
- Only full professing members are eligible to vote, and you must be present to cast your ballot.
- Please try to arrive by 3:30 p.m. (or earlier) to help us with registration (doors will open at 3:00 p.m.).
- Please enter through the Welcome Center doors (drop-offs can also use the side Wesley Hall door).
- Child-care is available, advance sign-up for that is not required, but it would be helpful if you could notify Kelly Potter or call the church office to alert us.
- We expect the meeting to last no more than one hour (subject to the D.S. who is presiding).
- As you should know, our Vision and Discernment Team, and our Church Council (our primary governing body), have both voted unanimously to recommend disaffiliation. We will essentially vote to agree or disagree with that recommendation. The vote will be either “yes” to disaffiliate from the United Methodist denomination, or “No” to remain in the United Methodist denomination. We will send a copy of the actual motion and rationale that we must use, with an explanation, in next week’s update.
- We will need a 2/3 supermajority or 67 % of the ballots cast by those who are present at this Church Conference to disaffiliate. Therefore, it is very important that you are present to participate in this vote.
