

Sunday, November 19, 2023, at 4:00 p.m.
Lakeside Park sanctuary (with overflow in the Wesley Hall)

At their November 7, 2023, meeting, our Immanuel Church Council affirmed a recommendation from our Vision and Discernment / Executive Team to hold a Church Conference / Congregational Meeting on November 19, at 4:00 p.m. for two purposes:

1. Electing lay leaders and ministry team members for 2024.
2. Holding a vote about affiliation with the Global Methodist Church (GMC).

The Vision and Discernment team unanimously voted to recommend to the Church Council that Immanuel affiliate with the GMC. After hearing their report, and upon further discussion, our Church Council also unanimously voted to recommend that Immanuel affiliate with the Global Methodist Church. Please see our website at www.immanuel-nky.org for more information.

Our gathering will include a time of worship and warm fellowship with your church family, and we expect the spirit to be positive and encouraging. We hope and pray you will make every effort to attend.

Eligibility to vote will be limited to full members of Immanuel.

If you are unsure about your membership status, please use the link on our website at: <https://immanuelchurch.breezechms.com/form/membershipstatus> or call the church office.

Please arrive early if possible - the doors will be open no later than 3:30 p.m. (additional parking will be available at the City of Lakeside Park City Building).

- Our ballot will be to either vote YES to affiliate with the Global Methodist Church (effective January 1, 2024).
- Or - NO - to not affiliate with the GMC (this would mean that Immanuel would become an independent / non-denominational church for the foreseeable future).
 - The GMC vote will be by confidential paper ballot. Results will be announced at the meeting.
 - This vote will require only a simple majority of the full members voting.

We will also be electing lay leaders / church officers for 2024 and ministry team members (hand vote). You can find the Nominations Report at our Church Conference link on our website homepage.

There are two options for EARLY VOTING (on the GMC Affiliation question only):

1. If you cannot be present on Sunday November 19 for our meeting, you may come to the church welcome center during office hours (9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.) between **Monday November 13 and Friday November 17** (on Friday only you will need to come before 4:30 p.m.). The receptionist will help you complete a confidential ballot (we will ask you to sign in so we can keep track of absentee ballots).
2. If you are physically unable to come to church under any circumstances due to disability or absence (e.g., you are out of town) you can email the church office at office@immanuel-nky.org or you may call 859-341-5330 (Paula Coyle or Christopher Cate) and we will discuss other ways to record your vote.


