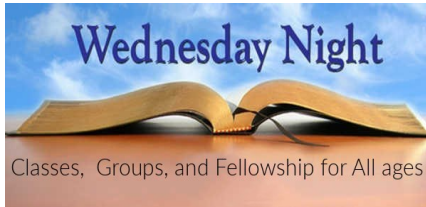

YOUTH MIDWEEK FELLOWSHIP



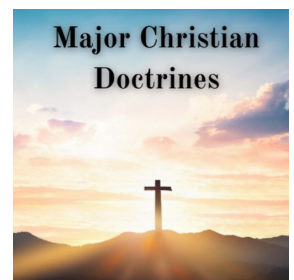

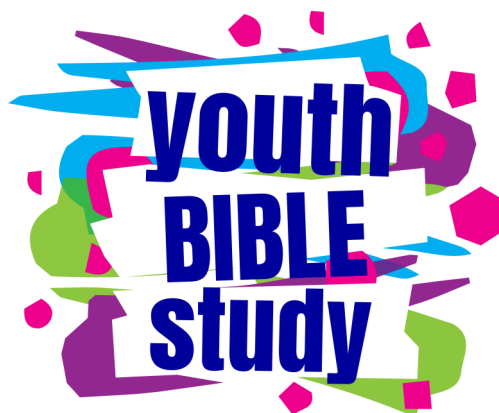
